PURPOSE:

The purpose of this external support resource is to diagnose the differences in import and domestic pumps and determine which parts on these pumps are interchangeable.

TOOLS REQUIRED:

PROCEDURE:

- 1. The easiest way to tell if a pump is an import or domestic model is to use the model number.
 - a. If the model number contains a "-I" at the end it is an import pump.
 - b. Currently, only 3 chamber pumps are imports.
- 2. Import models have a different upper housing assembly (pump head) and differing valve plates than the domestic pumps.
- 3. The switch, motor, and lower housing assembly can be replaced or switch back and forth between the two pumps.
 - a. We are not able to get parts for the import pumps, so we cannot sell replacement parts for these models.
 - b. These replacement parts that are not available include;
 - i. Upper housing assembly
 - ii. Valve plate assembly
